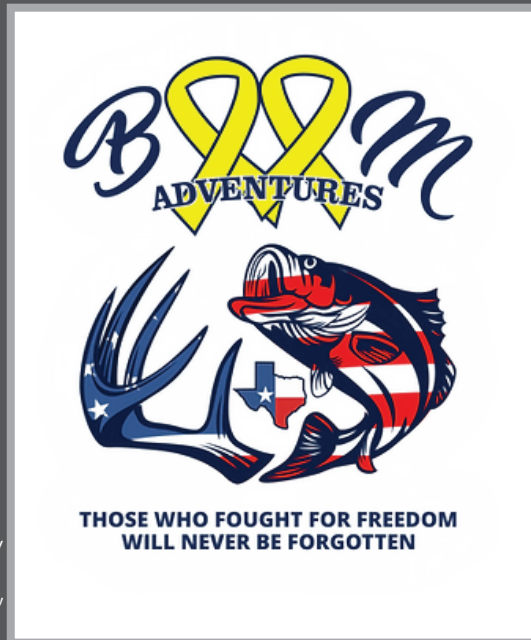




COMMUNITY SPOT LIGHT
