One of the benefits of the panhandle region is having a large region with diverse landscape. This is especially exciting if you enjoy being outdoors, hiking or especially biking. Six Pack Outdoors is a local nonprofit that is dedicated to preserving local open spaces so that generations to come can enjoy the outdoors. Six Pack outdoors aims to leave a lasting legacy by maintaining several local trail systems as well as contributing to the well-being of our community and environment. Six pack currently maintains the 9th street trails which is just north of Medi Park. This trail system allows hikers and bikers several miles of terrain to hone their outdoors trail skills. Six pack also maintains trails in Borger known as the Chad Alan Foster Memorial Trails as well as the Rick Klein Trails which host 15 miles of trail systems as well as a water crossing and a pump track for those riders who are looking to build rhythm on their 2 wheeled stallion. Six Pack also hosts several races throughout the year to challenge riders of all skill levels to get out ride, compete and make new friends. Proceeds from these races go to fund trail work and maintenance of the local trail systems. Six Pack believes everyone should have access to the natural beauty and benefits of outdoors recreation.
